Situation	A Vadosity engineer, working as a government subcontractor, was assigned to come up with a plan to solve a problem in 6 months with a small team (5 contractors or less).
The Problem	The government wanted to provide medical researchers with single-sign-on capability to a Windows RDP environment. User credentials needed to be passed through the operating system, web browser, Java server, and ultimately to a SQL Server database. A solution had eluded two separate teams of architects and engineers for 18 months.
Solution	Feeling that a solution was close, the Vadosity engineer took the initiative and took another shot at the problem over a long weekend. With innovation and intense focus, our engineer solved the problem late on Sunday night after logging 13 hours of overtime.
Outcome	The solution enabled medical researchers to safely access Veteran health data with the goal of discovering life-saving trends. The solution also saved the government an estimated \$500K and eliminated a further 6-month delay. Our engineer then led the effort to implement the solution across teams and in other task orders.
